

CHALK VOCABULARY

This outdoor activity helps with spelling and reading skills.

ITEMS YOU WILL NEED:

1. Outdoor chalk
2. Bucket of water
3. Sponge or rag
4. Clean concrete area

This can also be done indoors with a chalkboard or dry erase board.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Have your child write a word from the list below (More advanced words can be used for higher grade levels.)
2. Ask the child to erase a vowel from the word using the wet sponge or rag.
3. Can you replace it with another vowel to make a new word?
4. Ask the child to erase a consonant.
5. Can you replace it with another consonant to make a new word?
6. Can you add any letters to the beginning or the end to make a new word?
7. Erase the word and write a new one, continuing the same process.
