We are excited about your admission to The University of Southern Mississippi! We want to ensure you understand the financial responsibility requirements for students interested in joining our institution.

A Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20 or DS-2019) will not be authorized until this form is completed and approved by the institution. In order to receive the Certificate of Eligibility, you must submit financial documents are written in English or are accompanied by a notarized English translation showing available liquid funds equal, or exceeding, to the amount listed on the Estimated Cost of Attendance. Proof of funding is required for the first year only; but, it is expected funding will continue for the duration of the student's program of study.

By signing below, you agree to the following statements:

- I have reviewed the Estimated Cost of Attendance and agree I will provide financial support so long as the student is enrolled at The University of Southern Mississippi. Financial support will meet or exceed the costs for tuition and mandatory student fees, mandatory health insurance, room and board, and other personal living expenses for nine months (fall and spring semesters).
- I certify all information contained within the financial support documents are true and accurate and the state funds are available for education and personal expenses of the student while studying at The University of Southern Mississippi.
- I understand the submission of false or inaccurate information can be grounds to terminate an application or rescind admission.
- I will notify the university immediately of any changes in the financial circumstances of the student and/or the sponsor.
- I certify if restrictions exist regarding the transfer of funds from my home country to the United States I have fully investigated them and am aware of the procedures I must follow to remit payment by the dates due at the institution.
- Financial assistance is limited for international students. Do not expect student employment as a means to cover required expenses unless you have received a graduate assistantship offer with your graduate admission.

These documents should be from the three months immediately preceding the document being signed.

Income tax statements, certificates of deposit, investment accounts that are not readily accessible, proof of property ownership and statements of employment are NOT acceptable as evidence of the availability of funds.
