- Abstract: The COVID-19 pandemic has changed education forever. More than 1.2 billion children in 186 countries are affected by school closures due to the pandemic. Regardless of preference, "Online teaching is no more an option, it is a necessity" (Dhawan, 2020). However, not all teachers are trained to teach online and not all students are fit for an online learning environment because of their learning styles. In addition, lack of online interaction makes online teaching and learning more challenging. This presentation discusses the strategies and practices for designing, developing, and delivering a technology-enriched online course, illustrated with actual examples from undergraduate and graduate online classes. This presentation intends to demonstrate how to create an effective online learning environment and to teach efficiently in that environment.
