SeaPerch is a STEM education program that equips teachers and students with necessary resources to design and build an underwater Remotely Operated Vehicle (ROV). Teams build ROVs from a kit comprised of low-cost, easily accessible parts and follow a curriculum that teaches engineering and ocean science concepts. ROV kits shall be provided to participating USM Regional SeaPerch teams. Previous technical experience is not required, just you and your interest!
