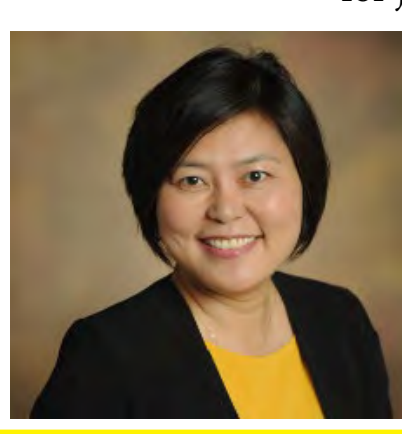
Shin Chosen for 2024 Scripps Howard Leadership Academy

The Southern Miss vs. Southeastern Louisiana game will be Saturday, Sept. 7, and USM Athletics has reserved parking lots for this event. Vehicles must be relocated based on the following:

Friday: Entry into Century Park North and Payne Center lots will close at noon, and all vehicles should be removed before 5 p.m. Vehicles will be towed from these lots beginning at 5 p.m. The lots will remain closed until 10 a.m. Sunday.

Saturday: Vehicles must be moved, or they will be towed from McCarty, Wilbur and Bolton halls, Hillcrest, Eagle Walk Lot, Ray Guy Way and Eagle Walk numbered spaces.

Vehicles parked in all other Eagle Club reserved areas must be moved by 7 a.m. on game day, or they will be towed at the owner's expense.

Open parking for game day is available in the following locations: Hillcrest Gravel, Sports Field, Pete Taylor, Ross Boulevard South, Arthell Kelley, 34th and 35th lots; the parking garage; north side of Theatre & Dance; Montague Open Zone and Fraternity Drive.
