ADDENDUM 1 THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) # 24-30 LAWN SERVICE AT THE VILLAGE, FRATERNITY ROW, AND CEDARBROOK APARTMENTS

USM RFP 24-30 is being amended to respond to the following proposed questions. USM RFP 24-30 is also being amended to extend the submission deadline to Friday, May 24, 2024, at 2 PM.

- 1. Regarding statement 13 under the USM general conditions, will the responding vendors and their prices be read aloud during the bid opening meeting? Yes.
- 2. As a benefit for both client and vendors, can USM send out property boundary maps for the locations covered by this RFP for more accurate pricing? Yes, see attachment, but a site visit would be of more benefit.
- 3. On Appendix A line 3 states 'Total area clean-up of debris and litter. Street and outside parking litter controlled by the university.' Can you please confirm that contractors are not responsible for any weed control in the parking lots? The Interior Sorority Village parking lot is included in the RFP.
- Can you please confirm that contractors are not responsible for crack weeds in hardscape areas? If so, please specify what areas contractors are responsible for. Sidewalks and porches are included in the RFP.
- 5. Should contractors apply pre- and post-emergent herbicides to the bed areas? If so, can you please specify how many applications USM desires? Post-emergent spraying as needed, however pulling of weeds is preferred.
- Regarding statement 4 under the scope of work, how many bed fertilizations should we include in our proposal? Fertilization schedule to be determined by landscape professional.

- 7. The specifications say the mowing and weeding should occur at least every 2 weeks during the growing season. Does this RFP consider April October as the growing season; what is the minimum number of visits required outside of the growing season? Can you please confirm the total number of visits per year that USM desires? Weekly site visits and inspections are required. The mowing schedule in winter months is as needed. The growing season is typically March through November.
- Turf chemical applications are not mentioned in the specifications, please confirm that USM would not like turf chemical treatments via this RFP. Turf chemicals are not requested.
- 9. The RFP requests only the labor for installation of 'plants, shrubs, flowers, mulch, pine straw, etc....", can you please clarify the mulch depth that USM desires or a bale/bag count of pine straw or mulch that contractors are to apply per year? Mulch depth is typically 4". Pine straw bale counts vary by year on an as needed basis.
- 10. Can you please specify the number, spacing, size, and how many applications of flowers that contractors are to apply per year? Flowers are usually planted once per year in front of the sorority houses. Shrubs are only replaced if needed.
- 11. Should the pricing for labor to install shrubs be included in our yearly price, or will this service be handled on a billable basis? If not on a billable basis, can you please confirm the total number and type of shrubs and plants that contractors are to install per year? Shrub replacement would be billable if replacement is needed.
