- Description of the commodity that USM is seeking to procure: Trimble Alloy Receivers
  and Software.
- 2. Explanation of why the commodity is the only one that meets the needs of the agency: The Trimble Alloy is the latest model of GNSS receiver replacing previous models (NetRS, NetR8, and NetR9). This Trimble equipment assures the Center maintains compatibility for use with an already existing network of Trimble permanent base stations.
- 3. Explanation of why the source is the only source is the only person or entity that can provide the required commodity: No other hardware has the ability to utilize the CMR+/CMRx protocol to integrate with our existing infrastructure. What makes the Trimble Alloy unique is that the units utilize a data stream referred to as CMR+ and CMRx. CMR+/CMRx is a proprietary Trimble signal developed to send datarom base stations to our existing Trimble Network Software Package (Trimble Pivot Platform).
- 4. Explanation of why the amount to be expended for the commodity is reasonable: No other hardware has the ability to utilize the CMR+/CMRx protocol to integrate with our existing infrastructure. Federally Funded Regional Geospatial Modeling Project.
- Efforts that the agency went through to obtain the best possible price for the commodity:
   USM negotiated with the vendor for the best possible price and received a discount.

The notice shall contain a detailed explanation of why the commodity is not a sole source procurement. Appropriate documentation shall also be submitted if applicable.

If after a review of the submitted notice and documents, USM determines that the commodity in the proposed sole source request can be provided by another person or entity, then USM will withdraw the sole source request publication from the procurement portal website and submit the procurement of the commodity to an advertised competitive bid or selection process.

If USM determines after review that there is only one (1) source for the required commodity, then USM will appeal to the Public Procurement Review Board. USM will have the burden of proving that the commodity is only provided by one (1) source.
