The University of Southern Mississippi anticipates purchasing the item(s) listed below as a sole source purchase. Anyone objecting to this purchase shall follow the procedures outlined below.

**1. Description of the commodity that USM is seeking to procure:**

The Children's Center for Communication and Development is seeking to procure a system to perform diagnostic behavioral audiometry to diagnose hearing disorders in children. The following equipment is needed:

Eckel CL-14A PRIME LP Audiometric Room with the following additional add-on features:

Door-Window in Door 20" W x 60"H (qty 1)  
Utilities- Sprinkler Head Access (qty 1)  
Features-Additional Duplex Outlets (qty 2).

**2. Explanation of why the commodity is the only one that meets the needs of the agency:**

The Children's Center serves children who are at-risk for developing hearing loss and many children who have documented diagnoses of hearing loss. The commodity requested is needed for our staff audiologist to be able to evaluate hearing abilities in this population. A sound-treated, calibrated audiometric room is necessary to achieve ANSI requirements for ambient noise for performing diagnostic hearing evaluations. The Eckel CL-14A PRIME LP Audiometric Room is the only audiometric room that can be installed in our space due to size restrictions and need for ADA compliance.

**3. Explanation of why the source is the only source is the only person or entity that can provide the required commodity:**

e3 Med-Acoustics has an exclusive contract with the manufacturers to distribute the required items in the state of Mississippi.

**4. Explanation of why the amount to be expended for the commodity is reasonable:**

The department considers the quoted cost reasonable due to the profound benefits that are provided exclusively by this system.

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**5. Efforts that the agency went through to obtain the best possible price for the commodity:**

The department has contacted the manufacturers and the distributor, e3 Med-Acoustics, to request competing quotes/bids. Both informed us that Med-Acoustics, Inc. is the sole distributor of the products to Mississippi agencies.
