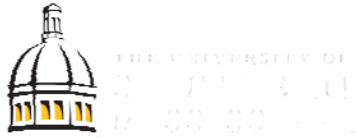

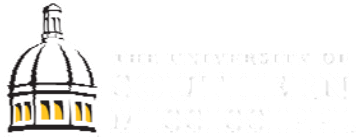

6. If online doors are included do we have a list of locations and what type of existing door hardware is there? Front doors and gates to buildings are online locks and are included, a list can be provided when an “intent to bid form” is completed. 7. Do you need mag stripes on the readers or is this contact only? No
8. Are we doing mobile at this time and if so is it going to be BLE or NFC? Not yet but plan for BLE
