This is an estimate provided for average costs of studying and living (9 months) at The University of Southern Mississippi. Actual amounts can differ based upon choices made about housing and spending habits. This estimate does NOT include the cost of living or studying in Hattiesburg during the summer semester or winter break period. Information about USM Cost of Attendance is available at: www.usm.edu/financial-aid/cost-attendance.

Each student, even those with full assistantships or scholarships, should arrive on campus with at least \$1,200.00 USD in cash, or a check/bank draft made out to the student, to cover initial personal expenses (food, housing, toiletries, etc.). In addition, at least 25% of tuition and fees will be due at the start of each semester and should be brought as a bank draft made out to The University of Southern Mississippi.

Health insurance is mandatory at The University of Southern Mississippi and a policy will be provided by the institution at a cost. There are very limited options to waive the health insurance, so please expect to be on the institution's student insurance policy. We have included an estimated amount for the insurance in the expenses listed above.
